HOBART RIVULET LINEAR PARK
Blackberry Infestation

Following a representation to the Hobart City Council by the SHPA, Council officers have agreed to eliminate this obnoxious weed from the banks of the Hobart Rivulet. The blackberries are particularly obvious near the entry to the Linear Park off Molle Street. Users of *The Walk* are encouraged to report any matter along the Park which detracts from its value — weeds, fallen limbs, etc. Ring the Council's **PARKWATCH** Direct Line on **6238 2812**.

The meetings were held in the 13th Hobart Scout Troop hall in Cascade Road. Membership stood at 61. Perennial issues, which still come up today, included Elliott Brothers Storage Yard on the Rivulet, resurfacing of Lynton Ave, shop trading hours for the Post Office, heavy vehicle parking in Macquarie St, play areas, lack of traffic control at D'Arcy St, safety fences on Huon Rd, and bus service extensions. In fact, with the replacement of the Huon Rd trolley buses with petrol driven vehicles, the Association took up the proposal to extend the service from stop 17 to stop 19A. It conducted a questionnaire which convinced the MTT to extend the service. [It can be seen that the Association was as active as it is now, then under the Presidency of Mr. Stan Mather, who is still involved, being our Senior Vice President, and a prime mover in organising our annual bonfire/fireworks night.]
