WHAT MAKES A COMMUNITY WORK?

(Reprinted from *The Mercury* 19th July, 2001)

Thanks to the Women's Action
Alliance (Letters, July 16) for
pointing out that, in this Year of the
Volunteer, the *Australian Bureau of*
Statistics has determined that
voluntary work won't be considered
in the August Census.

Which means the ABS has joined our
powerbrokers and newsmakers in
putting unpaid work into the
unimportant basket. What makes a
community work? Why do some
communities survive and thrive in
the face of worldwide trends in the
opposite direction? Why is it that
successful communities often exist
in economically deprived places?

Our popular culture has made a
fashion statement out of division
and isolation—characteristics of
social dysfunction. This is just what
we don't need. A successful
community depends on people pulling
together, helping each other,
recognising that our social fabric
includes everyone, not just the
powerful, rich and beautiful.
It also depends on our public
recognising that unpaid work keeps
us ticking—that while we may
manage without the big
moneyspinners we most certainly will
fall apart without our volunteers.
These people have none of the
prestige and comfort that
accompany financial wealth.

They get their reward from direct
human contact, from **Real Life**. They
understand there's another kind of
wealth, or capital, that has nothing
to do with the dollar sign. We can
call it social capital, and we will
continue to ignore
it at our peril.
