COUNCIL OF HOBART PROGRESS ASSOCIATIONS

The Association's main roll is to liaise with the HCC and other authorities, such as the State Government, on matters concerning the whole of Hobart. An issue occupying much time at present concerns the matter of the status of various types of open spaces in the municipality, especially considering recent controversial proposals to allow certain open spaces, such as Manning Reef, to be made available for private development.
